Oswald T. "Ozzie" Huseboe, 81, of Blair, WI, passed away Friday, August 15, 2014, at Gundersen Lutheran Medical Center, La Crosse, WI. He was born in Taylor, WI, on April 29, 1933, to J. Gordon and Alice (Sampson) Huseboe.

Oswald was raised in the Taylor area and was a 1951 graduate of Taylor High School. Following high school, he moved to Milwaukee, WI, and worked for Allis Chalmers. During his 18 years in Milwaukee, Oswald served in the United States Army from April 9, 1953 until his discharge on April 8, 1955.
