

## **DOLORES THOMPSON**

**NORTHFIELD** – Dolores LaVon Thompson, 86, of Northfield, died Friday, May 2, 2014 at Pigeon Falls Health Care Center in Pigeon Falls.

Dolores was born October 19, 1927 to Calmer and Alice (Erickson) Halverson on the family farm in the Pine Creek area, rural Hixton. She was baptized and confirmed by Rev. Urberg. She attended Pine Creek Grade School. After graduating from Black River Falls High School in 1945 she attended technical school in Eau Claire. From August of 1945 until 1946 she worked at Fort McCoy processing discharge papers for the soldiers returning from the war. She later worked in the clerical department of US Rubber (Uniroyal) as a typist and key punch operator.

On November 8, 1947 Dolores married James Thompson. Together they farmed in the Town of Northfield until 2005 when they retired, due to ill health, and moved to Pigeon Falls. James preceded her in death on May 4, 2011.

Dolores enjoyed doing handwork, quilting, reading and hosting many family gatherings. She was a member of South Beef River Lutheran Church where she taught Sunday School and was involved with the Ladies Aid.

Dolores is survived by her daughter, Sandra (Richard) Isaacson of Hixton; sons, Ronald (Susan) Thompson of Northfield and Robert (Tammie) Thompson of Whitehall; two grandsons, Mason and Wayne Thompson; step grandson Douglas Marshall. She is further survived by a sister, Betty (Grant) Simmons of Nekoosa; a brother, Larry (Kathy) Halverson of Nekoosa and several nieces and nephews.

In addition to her husband, Dolores was preceded in death by her parents, Calmer and Alice; sisters, Eileen Olson and Ardyce Simonson.
